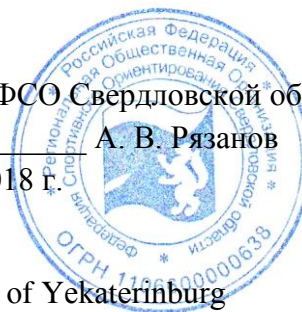

of the Open Sport Orienteering Championship of Yekaterinburg
«URAL-2018»

Goals and objectives

- Popularization of sport orienteering as the most accessible global sport;
- Improving skills of the athletes;
- Development of friendly relations among the athletes.

Development of friendly relations among the athletes.

Time and place of the competition. The competition will be held from June 8 to 12, 2018 in the city of Yekaterinburg. The venue is a forest in the vicinity of the village of Severka in the Railway District of the city of Yekaterinburg. The competition hub is the recreation center 'Extreme-Sport' on the shore of Peschanoye Lake.

Organizers

The organizers are the Department for the Development of Physical Culture, Sports and Tourism of the Administration of the City of Yekaterinburg and the Regional Public Organization 'Federation of Sport Orientation of the Sverdlovsk Region'. The competition is run by a panel of judges, approved by the organizers.

RR – with full marking. The distance is marked from start to finish with a white ribbon lying on the ground. Marking is included in the map in solid orange. All CP are located on the marking.

TR – marking-based course (control points are on the marked course or some distance from the marking, the marking is included in the map).

Maps

Maps are prepared (adjusted) in 2013-2017. Authors: Dyakov Aleksandr, Sergey Soldatov, Yashpatrov Gennady, Skripko Sergey, Myatovich Sergey, Efimov Sergey. Scale: –1:2500, 1:5000, 1:7500, 1:10000. Section: – 5m, 2,5 m.

Area

Altitude: 200 - 300 meters above sea level. Drop on one slope of up to 100 meters. The area is a closed territory, median terrain with the presence of major landforms, rocks and stones. Mixed, deciduous and coniferous forests. Forest coverage - 95%. Visibility - from average to poor. Permeability - variable. Road network is underdeveloped.

Punching

All groups use the electronic punching system by SportIdent. Participants get to the start with their own chips. For those who do not have their own SportIdent chips, the chips will be rented in the competition center at a price of 50 rubles per day of the competition.

Start

Each day of the competition will have two starting positions, according to the Scheme of start and finish positions.

Finish

Each day of the competition will have two finishing positions, according to the Scheme of start and finish positions. Participants who retired from the race must go through the finish line!

Securing participants

The safety of participants in the competition hub is ensured by the on-duty staff of the Emergencies Ministry and security of the 'Extreme-Sport' recreation center. Representatives of junior teams (teams with athletes under the age of 18) must be at the finish line and, at the end of the finish, notify the chief judge or the senior referee that all the team members have finished.

Admission conditions

Accommodation of participants in the tent camp (in places according to the approved plan of the competition hub). Participants may reserve places in the competition hub houses and in nearby sports bases. For house booking please contact the organizers of the competition. The competition hub will have organized trade of sports goods and a hot shower. The recreation center 'Extreme-Sports' provides paid accommodation for personal vehicles on the territory, in places intended for parking. It will also provide free guarded parking spots outside the recreation center in accordance with the approved plan of the competition hub.

ATTENTION! Starting bonfires on the soil is only allowed in explicitly established spots.

Otherwise, use barbecues and iron boxes. Teams that violate this provision will not be allowed to compete, their entry fee will not be refunded. It is recommended to use gas for cooking.

ATTENTION! It is forbidden to dig garbage pits, all garbage should be packed in plastic bags and stored in a garbage container in the area of the competition. Garbage bags can be obtained at the competition hub from the commandant. All expenses for travel, food and accommodation of participants are borne by the sending organizations.

Results and awarding

Medalists are determined in each age group (except OPEN groups) separately among boys and girls, men and women in each kind of program. Medalists for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd days of the competition are awarded with medals, diplomas and souvenirs. On the fourth day, competitions are held with a delayed start. Group A of the finals allows athletes who lost not more than 45 minutes to the leader during the first three days of the competition combined. The starting time of the competitor is determined by his loss to the leader after the first three days of the competition combined. (in minutes and seconds). Athletes who do not qualify for group A of the finals start in group B. The start of group B is staggered (1-minute interval), starts 5 minutes after the start of the last participant of group A, according to the place occupied by the sum of time of the three days. The athlete's position is determined by the order of arrival at the finish, regardless of the athlete's belonging to the group A or B. The winners of the multi-day event are awarded cups, medals, diplomas and valuable prizes. Prize-winners of the multi-day event are awarded with medals, diplomas and prizes.

Financing and paraphernalia from the organizers

The expenses associated with the preparation of maps, distances, paying the jury, and awards are paid by: Office for the Development of Physical Culture, Sports and Tourism in Administration of the city of Yekaterinburg and the Organizing Committee of «Ural 2018»

Participation applications

Preliminary applications for participation in the competition need to be submitted no later than May 31, 2018 through the online application system.

Responsibility for the security and safety of life of minor participants on the road and during the competition is assigned to the coaches and team representatives. Applications are submitted in accordance with the established form.

The application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- medical admission to the competition (medical certificate of health, certified by the seal of the medical institution)
- original insurance contract

The entry fee rate from one participant in the competition.

Environmental fee for all days is 150 rubles.

Cost of the application fee for "OPEN" group on the day of registration 8 and 9 June, is 400 rubles per day and 1,300 rubles for 4 days.

Group C6 only requires provisional application, the application fee can be paid on the day of registration. Payment of environmental charges is not required for group C6.

MW70 group is allowed to start without having to pay the application fee if the application is available.

Pupils of Yekaterinburg municipality schools are allowed to compete without having to pay the application fee if the application is available before May 31, 2018.

Family discount of 20% is available to parents with children in the composition of 3 or more people. Applies only to the entry fee.

Refund of application fee is possible until May 31 inclusive in the amount of 100%
